

TRUSTEES' REPORT  
to Genelle Improvement District  
at Annual General Meeting – December 2, 2020

Business activities and special projects of the GID for 2019/20 included:

- Ongoing correspondence with RDKB Area B Director questioning RDKB withdrawal of Fire Hydrant Maintenance Agreement;
- Completed Confined Space Assessments and secured equipment;
- Request for Quotes to compete old reservoir repairs;
- New reservoir final building inspection completed by RDKB;
- Resignation of Administrator – duties temporarily filled by trustee, Darlene Espenhain, pending posting and replacement;
- Water Operator on medical leave – duties filled by casual helper;
- Surplus equipment sold (machine and meter parts and old sink);
- Exploration into solar power for GID wells;
- Added amber lights to service truck and secured permit to operate;
- Outside and garage lights at GID office replaced with LED;
- Installed lock on gate to reservoir;
- Grading completed on road to reservoir;
- Extended Waste Management contract at same cost to March 2021;
- GID signage on office updated;
- Secured quotes for gas furnace in GID office;
- General maintenance of GID infrastructure and facilities;
- Ongoing review and updating of GID Bylaws and policies as required and appropriate;
- Communication with GID ratepayers and service providers;
- Meeting with Auditor to review and approve the 2019 fiscal year audit for presentation to the GID community and the provincial ministry:
